

## Commonwealth Countries

In general, UK entry clearance issuing posts in non-Commonwealth countries - with the exception of those in Antananarivo in Madagascar, Reykjavik in Iceland and Libreville in Gabon - issue visas on behalf of most independent Commonwealth countries that do not have representation in that country.

There are, however, several exceptions to this and you should contact either a representative of the Commonwealth country that you intend to visit, or your nearest British mission overseas where you can get up-to-date information. Listed below are some of the countries for which entry clearances cannot be issued.

The British mission will charge an administration fee for issuing a visa for a Commonwealth country, and the country may also charge a visa fee on arrival there.

Some countries for which entry clearances cannot be issued:

Australia	Malta	Singapore
Bangladesh	Namibia	Solomon Islands
Fiji	Nauru	Tanzania
Ghana	Pakistan	Uganda
Guyana	Papua New Guinea	Vanuatu
India	Seychelles	Western Samoa
